1 Overview

This is a peer-reviewed for the paper format of the 18th IEEE Hiroshima Section Student Symposium. When writing the manuscript of the paper, you have to follow this format. As for English paper, the format is similar.

2 Style

Using the A4 size document. 20mm margin all around (top, right, left), so that the document is fit in the interior region. For the text code, use the SJIS.

2.1 Title Section

Use larger font for title. The size of the character used must be around 14 16point. For Author's name, use 10point font. Use bold font when there is no large font. Write down every affiliation for each authors, even though there are multiple authors and different affiliations.

2.2 Body

1. Text size is between 9pt to 10pt.
2. Body text should be in 2 paragraph for 2 to 4 pages (printed both side). (Do not insert page number)
3. Use formal format for the text and make it in simple sentences. Standardized the punctuation such as dots, (.) and comas (,).
4. Use the same terms in the whole body.
5. Use brackets () for abbreviation. Footnote is also possible.
6. Arabic number characters are standardized.

2.3 Diagrams, tables and photos

1. As a guideline, in 1 piece of A4 size paper, there are 1 to 2 points of diagrams that clearly draw. Add a title, serial number in figures and tables.
2. Since the figure/photograph will be printed as the document itself, draw larger, be careful with the thickness of the line, shading, and the size of the characters.
3. Do not forget to insert the axis's name and unit for both vertical axis and horizontal axis of the graph.

2.4 Literature

1. Citations are given a serial number for appearance in the text, put [1] in the text of the relevant part.
2. One number per literature is adapted. Another literature with the same author is written with a different number.
3. Be sure to specify the source of literature citations, if necessary, ask the approval of the original author.
4. The author of the literature is shown by writing the full name if it in the Japanese, write the initials if it in English.

3 Notice of patent

This symposium is not object the Article 30 Paragraph 1 Patent Act (exception of the lack of new invention). For this reason, if you are planning to apply the patent of the presentation contents at this symposium, we would like you to apply a patent application that will be collected on the date (21st November 2016).
