Technical Presentation

In this symposium, we will provide Technical Presentation as a place for student presentations. The Technical Presentation is the announcement method which encourages the exchange of opinions between a general participant and the presenter. Presenters can use various research equipment's during Technical Session. In International (English) Session, the presenter makes a poster in English. During Technical Session, the presenter describes his/her poster in English.

Paper Submission

Those who participate in this symposium, you need to register the information on your paper first. Registration contents include "title of a research", "author", "field" and "summary (about 300 words)". For that summary, please write down clearly and simply. Then, after registering information, you need to submit a paper for review before **September 1st**. Whether your paper is accepted for presentation or not is decided based on peer reviews. Finally, the selected authors must submit "the final manuscript (camera-ready)" before **October 10th** in consideration of the comments from the reviewers and do a technical presentation at the venue based on "the final manuscript (camera-ready)".

Number of manuscripts should be 1~3 pages for peer review papers and 1-4 pages for final papers.
